

Product Review: Purple Slice

I'm writing about a fantastic polish I came across during Bike Week. First off, to give those who have no clue to who I am and what I did in another lifetime, let me bring you up to speed. For thirty years I owned a custom paint and body shop. Yup, did a lot of rubbing and polishing of paint, chrome, aluminum, and whatever else needed it. As my friends know; as a hobby, I work on my own cars now. I'm kind of



a Jag nut, so I own 4 of those. Two are done and two I'm still working on. I have one Ferrari - all done, a '53 Studebaker, etc. etc. etc. The reason I'm telling you about my cars is so you can get an idea of how much polishing I do on a regular basis. It's a LOT. In the past, I've usually custom mixed my polishes to obtain the shine I want.

Mark, from the famous Hog Wear company, told me he was taking on the Purple Slice line and he gave me a little example bottle to try out. He had his bike sitting there and it looked really good. I told him I would try it, BUT I would be brutally honest about it. It looked like a small bottle of Windex to me. I wasn't expecting any more from it than I've seen from any other liquid polish.

One morning we were on our way to a Chester's HD event. I knew they'd be set up there and Mark would be asking what I thought. I had a little time before we left, so I tried it out on our Harley Softail Custom. Was I amazed! Not only by the incredible shine it produced but how quick and easy it was. Out of a liquid?

Well, since then I've bought two big bottles; to do my little fleet and to hand out samples to my

friends.

This product shines anything it gets close to. It makes your windshield seem invisible, and your paint and chrome as if you can walk through it... and all with very little effort. They have a great aluminum polish also. It works instantly. I wish we'd had this quality of a product when I was in

the business. It would have saved a whole lot of time.

Honestly, it took a couple of times on the Ferrari to see much difference; as the shine from the factory is already very exceptional. The black 5th Avenue started out needing a compound rub first. Then when Purple Slice was applied, it took only a couple of times to get what you see in the picture.

Now the only thing I don't know yet is the longevity of the shine. That is, before you have to re-apply the polish. Because I keep most all my cars under car covers, the only thing I've done in the couple of months since polishing everything is dust them off. They all look good so far. Beside, when that day comes - whether it is soon or later, who cares? It only takes a short time to spray Purple Slice on, wipe it off, and the shine is incredible.



Another factor that I like about this product is that it is LOW tox; whereas those old formulas of mine included some higher toxic chemicals. They'd get into your skin, were tough to breathe, lots of chems flashing off into the air ... nasty stuff. Granted, just because a product smells 'good' is no indication that it is 'safe' for you or for the environment. Purple Slice is proud of the fact that it is biodegradable and contains NO solvents or toxins. The MSDS lists NO hazardous components.

I highly recommend you try Purple Slice... on your bike, car, bathroom mirrors, windshields, computer monitors, windows, whatever you've got that needs a shine.
